POLITICAL POWER

Babylon represents a religious power, and the beast represents political powers.

Opposite to ancient times, religious and political powers will be easily differentiated at the End Time.

Babylon is seated on the beast, so religion will control politics and will use it again to get drunk with the blood of the saints.

Babylon tries to replace the High Priest by wearing purple and scarlet, jewelry and a head plate with an inscription (see Exodus 28).
